ICU HiTech bed is equipped with the most advanced technology for the patient intensive care.

Its three rectangular lifting and lateralization columns are safety and durability warranty. Multiple options are available to satisfy the patient care necessities, which optimize the work of the caregivers.

The bed lateralization allows patient better oxygenation to avoid complications and facilitates his dairy care.

The rails have an anti-fall protection system that locks the bed lateralization whilst the rails are lowered.

Foot section positioning system in different angles by a hinge.

Double regression system, it reduces the pressure in the thorax area, minimizing the pressure ulcers risk (PU's) (165 mm \pm 10 mm).

X-ray ready because of its radio transparent backrest.

- Easy handling:

Membrane control integrated in the rails that facilitate the bed positioning for the patient and for the caregiver. The rails come assembled with two inside membrane controls and two external for the caregiver.

The bed has a battery in case the main power fails or the bed is unplugged. It allows doing more than 300 complete movements.

High precision weighing system, installed in the rails that allows the tracking and monitoring of the patient condition.

- Optional customizable vinyls in colour and logo.

HiTech bed has a wide range of accessories and complements that enable to comply with all the needs of a hospital room and intensive care units.

- 200 mm. legs section extensible length.

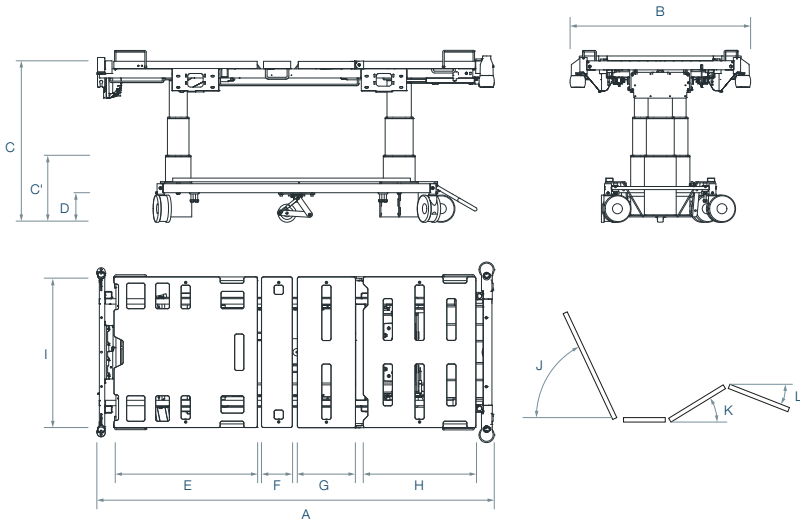
